#### The View from our CEO

At VWHRC our number 1 goal is ENDING VETERAN HOMELESSNESS.

This happens by getting our veterans back on their feet and enjoying life with a purpose. This year has been incredibly rewarding due to the tiny homes opening and adding the Veterans Cafe & Museum. Step 1 occurs at our Hutton House in Little River, this location is where our veterans get back on their feet. Step 2 occurs at the tiny homes in Myrtle Beach where our veterans enjoy life. And last but not least step 3 occurs at our cafe or job the veteran has obtained to give them purpose.

The process for each of our veterans has completely different elements and after 5 years of doing this not a single veteran has the same exact story.

This makes a cookie cutter approach impossible to put a veterans life back together again. There are countless hours to make this work and we can never thank the groups and individuals enough for helping VWHRC end veteran homelessness, but thank you again!

In the beginning of 2025, one of our Hutton House residents who has been with us for almost 3 years got his VA disability benefits from nothing to 100% and was able to move into his own home! He still comes around the Hutton House and truly enjoys being around other veterans.

## **Command Center Briefing**

#### The View from our CEO

Just recently one of our tiny home residents was able to get his benefits raised and successfully went from the Hutton House to Tiny Homes to his his own place! This resident has been extremely helpful to VWHRC since arrival. He jumped at any task given to help fellow veterans hang lights, assist with landscaping, and move numerous items for others.

On any day of the week VWHRC will take in over 20 calls, assist our over 30 residents, feed a few handfuls of customers, collect donations, process VA claims, provide financial assistance, make a few cups of coffee and converse with nearly a hundred veterans. Again without the help of this community none of this would even be possible so thank you again!

I challenge you this year to begin donating just a dollar a month online to help VWHRC end veteran homelessness.



During the first half of 2025, VWHRC continued delivering essential housing, benefits, and financial support to veterans. Programs remained on track for grant usage, service delivery, and community engagement goals. key highlights include high occupancy at tiny home village and Hutton house, urgent medical support, and targeted financial assistance to prevent eviction and utility shutoffs.

## **VWHRC Highlights:**

- Housing Stability: Maintained occupancy at the Tiny Home Village and
  Hutton House, providing emergency placements and preventing
  homelessness
- Medical support: Covered urgent dental care for veterans
- Crisis Support: Provide hotel lodging for veterans awaiting permanent housing placement.
- Financial Assistance: Prevented evictions and utility shutoffs through targeted rental, arrears, and utility payments.
- Veteran Engagement: Assisted 6 combined arms referrals and contributed 74 hours to VA claims support during this period.

# Upcoming Focus Areas

- Monitor SCDVA grant usage to ensure full expenditure by quarterend.
- Expand outreach for claims assistance to increase engagement hours above last quarter.
- Schedule volunteer workdays to enhance Tiny home Village infrastructures.
- Continue providing emergency financial, housing, and medical support for high-need veterans.
